Who can borrow a pass?

Museum Passes may be borrowed by Mount Vernon Public Library cardholders 18 and over in good standing. All fines must be paid and overdue items returned before borrowing a pass.

How do I make a reservation?

Passes may be reserved online at: http://www.eventkeeper.com/code/events.cfm?curOrg= MVPL&curapp=passes

or by calling Mount Vernon Public Library up to a month in advance. One pass at a time may be borrowed per family and no more than three reservations can be made in a 30 day period. Make the reservation for the date of your visit. Print the confirmation sheet and bring it to the library when picking up a pass.

Where do I get the pass?

The pass can be picked up at the Children's Room Desk 914-668-1840 ext. 211, the day before the visit and returned the day after. The pass may not be left in the book drop or returned to another library and it cannot be renewed.

What about Fines?

A fine of \$10 will be charged each day the pass is late or if it is returned in the book drop or to another library. The full cost of the pass will be charged to the cardholder if the pass is lost. The cost of each pass varies and can be as high as \$500.

What if I have to cancel my reservation?


If the reservation is more than 24 hours ahead, use the "my passes" link on the reservation page to cancel. If less than 24 hours, visit the library or call the Children's Room Desk. It is important that you cancel since the reservation blocks out three days.
